Trinity Apartments Eligibility Criteria

In order to qualify for consideration for accommodation at Trinity Apartments, please note the following:

- The scheme is intended principally for people aged 55 and over. However applicants under the age of 55 with a disability will also be considered.
- You must already live in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull or have a strong family connection with the area (*Note; First priority will be given to applicants who currently live in the Borough*).
- You must have the ability to live independently with care and support provided.
- You must have some personal care and/or support needs and be willing to take part in a community assessment which will identify your level of need.

If you meet these basic eligibility criteria, you are invited to complete an application form for accommodation.

Consideration of a completed application will necessitate a home visit being arranged to view your existing accommodation and to discuss your care and support needs.

A report on your application will then be presented to an Allocations Panel which will decide one of the following:

- Your application is approved and you are to receive an offer of accommodation.
- Your application is approved and you are to be admitted onto the Trinity Apartments waiting list.
- Your application has been unsuccessful.

Whatever the decision, you will be notified accordingly as soon as possible once a decision has been made.
